RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

- To teach classes according to the curriculum guidelines
- To prepare a yearly scheme of work as well as termly and weekly plans for the classes to be taught
- To work in conjunction with colleagues to ensure an interdisciplinary approach to learning
- To maintain high quality learning within all subject areas.
- To design appropriate learning strategies to deliver the curriculum.
- To undertake regular training for professional development to update practice and methodology
- To participate in staff meetings, training days, parents evenings and school functions according to the published schedule
- To supervise, and where possible instruct, students in extra classroom activities such as sports and games, trips and clubs
- To participate in regular duties outside lesson times.
- To provide cover as and when required by line manager
- To set and mark homework according to the schedule
